*Get a head start on your Bachelor's of Social Work at EMU–Livonia!*

If you're considering a career in social work, your educational path to EMU just became even more seamless. Before being admitted into the Bachelor's of Social Work program at EMU, you're required to complete three introductory courses with a grade of "C" or better. Now, two of these courses are available at EMU–Livonia, conveniently located at Six Mile Road and I-275. You can enroll in these courses while completing your community college coursework so that when you transfer to EMU, you can be ready to join on campus students in the program!

## **Social Work at EMU**

- SWRK 251 Self-Assessment and Development, 1 credit (Fall 2006)

## **Advising**

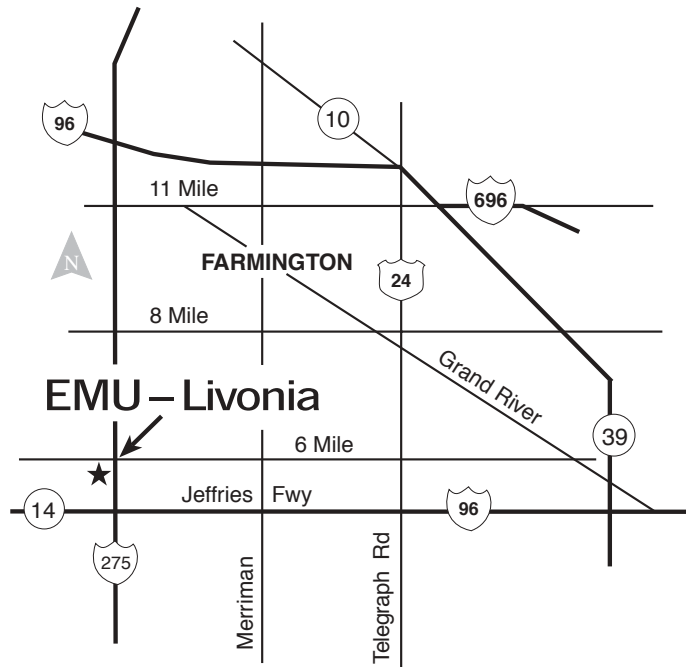
